LYRICAFEST is a two-week intensive chamber music festival located in Lincoln MA, 3 minutes from historic Walden Pond. Five to six string ensembles will be formed from college, graduate and advanced high school students who will have prepared in advance an assigned work. Each group will perform in master classes, outreach venues and a final public concert.

The festival takes place in a lake front home and neighboring host families surrounded by acres of conservation land.

LYRICAFEST's intimate setting, home-cooked meals and nightly sightreading with faculty are just a few of its unique aspects. Last year's participants represented students from the Juilliard Eastman, Longy, Indiana, Hartt Schools of Music, and the New England, Oberlin and San Francisco Conservatories.
